## Fee: \$500 for the Cantor to officiate the ceremony.

- For your convenience, the fee is a flat rate.
- There are no "packages" to choose from.
- The approach for putting together a ceremony is the same for all couples.
- The fee does not change if there is a co-officiant as the amount of work is the same (or greater).
- Additional services incur additional costs as described below.
- A deposit of half the fee (\$250) and a signed contract are required to book the wedding date.

## **Services provided:**

- Officiating the wedding ceremony (including the ketubah signing, if applicable).
- Filing the marriage license.
- Two meetings (one initial meeting to get to know each other and ask questions, and one before the wedding to finalize the ceremony).
- All other email and phone communication with the couple as needed.
- Communicating with an event planner, venue coordinator, or day of assistant as needed.
- Assistance preparing for or running the rehearsal (attendance optional based on availability).
- Assistance purchasing the ketubah (if applicable) and procuring other materials necessary for the ceremony.

## Additional services (fees vary):

- Extra meetings
- Providing an accompanist
- Travel outside of the Chicagoland area
- A day-of technical assistant for Zoom weddings

Please note, due to the pandemic all meetings and ceremonies will currently be held **online only** until it is safe to be together in person, especially due to the heightened risk from aerosolization of the Coronavirus through singing. When scheduling in advance for in-person ceremonies, keep in mind that adjustments or alternatives to plans may need to be made for everyone's health and safety.
