#### WHY PHOTOGRAPHY IS A WORTHY INVESTMENT



Memories are the most valuable thing you'll ever own. Memories are treasures. They're precious. Without photographs— the only way we can relive a memory is inside of our heads. Without photographs— the only way we can share our sweet memories with others is by speaking of them. Memories are so valuable. And that is why I believe that photography is one of the most underrated investments in this life. Photographs are family heirlooms. Have you ever gone through old albums of your grandparents or parents? I know I have. It makes me feel like I'm looking into the past, seeing moments in time that I never would have seen without photography. And that is such a gift.

If you are looking for a photographer who is "a good value"— I might not be the best fit for you. And that's ok. travel fees are not included in collections. this includes weddings more than 60 miles outside of the general twin cities area. reach out to get a specific quote on mileage/airfare/lodging fees for your specific situation.



Keep in mind the timeline will change based on the season, time of year, how many hours you choose, ceremony time, etc. This is just an exmaple.

#### KEEPING THINGS HONEST & TRUE TO YOU

These are your memories. Not mine. Which is why it's my goal to create a safe space for you to be your true & unfiltered selves with me (& my camera). I want to give you an experience and a gallery of images that feels genuine, not forced. I want to get to know you, to learn about your quirks, your likes, your dislikes. I don't want to create a replica experience for every single one of my couples. What I do with one couple, I might not do with the next. We're all so different & that's what makes us beautiful. So let's collaborate, let's lean into whatever makes you you and create an experience that reflects that.

#### MYAPPROACH TO SHOOTS & WEDDINGS

I like to consider my approach a collaboration. Without your willingness to let me into your story OR without my ability to create a safe & welcoming space for you— the end result might fall flat. We are both needed to create magic. My shooting approach is to keep things comfortable & stress-free, while giving cues & direction that will evoke *real* emotion between the two of you. I don't want to be in your face the entire time. I don't want to be talking & taking up space the whole session (*although I am big on words of affirmation— encouragement is a part of working with me*). I want to give you the space to be with another & create real moments that I would never be able to create by overwhelming you with pose after pose.

#### WHAT I NEED FROM YOU

You might think you're awkward in front of the camera. Trust me— almost all of my couples tell me that (or that they have no experience getting their photos taken). That's 1000% ok (& normal!). My request from you is to simply trust me. To set your expectations aside for whatever you thought the shoot might be & just *be present*. To show up with an open mind. It might not happen in the first 10 minutes, but I want to get to a place where you allow me to see your silly quirks. I want you to feel comfortable & at ease. I want you to let your guard down & let me in so that I'm able to tell the story of your love in a real way. That's where the real magic happens.





#### Don't see your question below? No worries— reach out with additional questions.

#### How many photos do we get?

Weddings: 600-1000 depending on your specific day

Sessions: 50-125 photos depending on the type of shoot.

#### How will I receive the images & do I get the print release?

Via online gallery (in which you will get a link & be able to download directly to your computer). And yeppp- the print release is all yours. I do have an amazing online store you can purchase super high-quality prints, albums, etc. from.

#### Do you ever give raw, unedited images?

I don't. Editing is a huge part of the end product you will receive.

#### What's your turnaround time?

2-4 weeks for shoots & 4-6 weeks for weddings (contractually it's longer, but that is only to cover my bases if a family emergency or something comes up).

#### Do you do sneak peeks?

You bet, my friend. My aim is to get you a small preview within 48-72 hours of the wedding day.

#### How would you describe your style?

Laid-back, intimate, soft, real and freespirited. I see beauty in simplicity & connection and creating images that evoke honest emotion. I like to keep the tones in my images earthy and warm.

#### We're awkward in front of the camera. Will this be an issue?

Wanna know a secret? 99% of the humans I work with feel this way in the beginning (I swear you're not alone!). Most of us aren't supermodels and I certainly don't expect you to be. That is why you hire me. It's MY job to make you feel comfortable and to direct you & guide you so that you feel relaxed & comfortable & confident. I pinky promise that by the end you will be having so much fun you barely realize a camera is pointed at you. Hold me to it. ;)

#### How many weddings do you take per year?

My happy spot is between 15-20 to insure I give each of my couples the amaaazing experience they deserve.

#### Do you work with a shot list?

I encourage you to create a family photo shot list (especially if there are unique family situations that I need to be sensitive to) and a "special" shot list of photos I wouldn't normally know to take (i.e. item you have to honor late loved one, recreating a photo your mom & dad did at their wedding, etc.). Otherwise, I like the freedom to shoot whatever is unfolding right in front of me.

#### What if there is bad weather?

Embrace it, friend! Different weather scenarios can actually create some really beautiful & unique images. BUT obviously if the weather is super terrible or dangerous— we can reschedle your shoot. For a wedding— we will create a back-up plan together.

#### Favorite Office character?

Michael Scott is my spirit animal. "Would I rather be feared or loved? Easy. Both. I want people to be afraid of how much they love me." I meann.....

#### Do you help me with the timeline for my wedding?

Of course! I provide example timelines in the guide I send out, but obviously every wedding day is different, so we will craft a timeline together for you that is going to fit the needs of your day.

#### Do you have a second photographer?

I have a few awesome partners that I will reach out to if you decide to add on a second shooter. If it's in budget- I always recommend adding a second photographer onto your collection. There are so many benefits to having another photog along. Reach out for more info.

#### Do you recommend doing an engagement session?

YEESS!! I include an engagement session in all of my collections for a reason. :) I find it to be a super important time to have together before the wedding day. There are no tight timelines, no guests to chat with, no wedding-day nerves. It's just you guys, me and my camera (& some good music!). It's the perfect time to continue to get to know one another. When you feel comfortable with me-— it makes a world of difference. The shoots are laid-back & fun— pinky promise.

#### Is this your "real job"? How long have you been doing photography?

Yepp it sure is. I officially went fulltime in May of 2018, but have been shooting weddings and lifestyle sessions "on-the-side" since 2013. I can honestly say that I love my job!

#### Can we bring pets to our shoot?

PLEASE DO!!! I am a major animal lover. Plus, furry friends are family IMO.

#### Can you photoshop us?

You are beautiful juuust the way you are, my friend. I don't do any major body manipulations or alterations. I do minor "photoshopping" with skin blemishes, bruises, etc.

#### Can we see a full gallery from a past shoot or wedding?

Of course you can! Just ask and I'll send an online gallery your way.

#### What the heck do we wear to our shoot?

I will send you all sorts of info on this— don't you worry. If you're wanting to get ahead of the game, I created a blog post all about it. Check it out on my website.

#### Do you travel? What are your travel fees?

I suuure do. I have a soul that craves adventure and experiencing new places, so count me in. Travel fees would consist of mileage/airfare, loging & rental car (if applicable).

#### Do you offer discounts?

Nope. My prices are firm.

#### What if we need to cancel or reschedule?

For weddings, there is a rescheduling fee of \$750 if the date is within six months of the original date. A new retainer will be required to book a date outside of six months of the original. If you cancel, the 30% retainer becomes a cancellation fee.

#### What happens if you can't make it to our wedding?

There would need to be something major happening for me not to be there. But in the case of emergency, illness, etc. I will do everything in my power to find a professional, trusted "associate" to shoot the wedding. Unless circumstances didn't allow, I would still edit & deliver the final gallery.

#### Do you do payment plans?

Typical payments are made in two chunks, but I am very open to creating a payment plan that spreads out the cost more if desired.

#### How can we book?

[happy dance] I'm so glad you feel connected to my work. In order to book a wedding, you are required to put down a 30% non-refundable retainer & sign a contract to secure your date. From there, I will be in touch with you about next steps. I cannot wait to work with you!
