ALL PRICES INCLUDE CEREMONY, RECEPTION, AND COORDINATION



*We offer a "mini" wedding package on Fridays and Sundays for groups of 50 or less at \$3,600.

WEDDING PACKAGES INCLUDE:

- Coordination (two face-to-face planning meetings, a final call 10 days out from wedding, and unlimited access to coordinator by phone and email)
- White padded ceremony chairs/set up
- Arbor for ceremony (arbor is optional under the pavilion)
- 8' wooden cross for ceremony (optional)
- Reception tables and chairs/set-up
- Choice of white or black floor length linens for round tables
- Choice of tan or gray overlays for round tables
- Water station on the patio for pre-ceremony and cocktail hour
- Multiple options for estate tables, sweetheart table, guest book table, gift table, memory table, cake, dessert station, buffet, drink station, ceremony unity, etc...
- High top cocktail tables for reception or cocktail hour use
- Patio heaters
- Indoor and outdoor stone fireplaces (firewood included)
- Fire pit (firewood included)
- Bridal suite for bride and bridesmaids to get ready/hang out in
- Groom's room for groom and groomsmen to get ready/hang out in
- 2 outdoor ceremony locations (one overlooking the pasture and the other under our 4,000 square pavilion)
- Ice machine
- Prep kitchen for caterer
- Use of any of our decor (lanterns, vases, crates, buckets, chalkboards, signs, easels, gold chargers, etc...)
- Use of the property for bridal portraits and/or engagement sessions (by appointment)

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- ALL clean up (you are only responsible for removing your own personal items)

GRANT HILL FARMS STAFF

Our staff here at Grant Hill Farms is absolutely the BEST! They are here to help make sure your day is nothing short of perfect. What does our staff do?

-All framework set up (tables and chairs for both ceremony and reception)

-Iron and place linens

-Set tables with plates, silverware, glasses, napkin, and water carafes (if applicable)

-Light candles

-Greet guests as they arrive

-Keep restrooms stocked

-Adjust heat and air as needed

-Keep trash emptied

-Final "sweep" of the reception hall while ceremony is taking place

-Set up and refill pre-ceremony and cocktail hour water station

-Handle lighting of fireplaces and fire pit as requested

-Fix bride and groom's dinner plates

-Release tables through buffet line

-Bus and clear trash from tables throughout the night

-Handle lighting and extinguishing of sparklers if you have chosen this as your exit

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-Help you gather your items at the end of the evening

-Put away any of GHFs decor that you may have used

-All clean up

COORDINATION

While we do not require you use our in-house coordinators, we highly recommend it and it is already included in your package pricing. We have 3 coordinators on staff that rotate. Collectively, our coordinators have coordinated over 300 weddings both here at Grant Hill Farms and other venues around the southeast. What to expect from your coordinator?

-Meeting 1: Your first meeting takes place no later than 6 months prior to your wedding date (we prefer to execute this meeting earlier depending on how far out you have booked). At this meeting we walk through all options for ceremony, reception, and cocktail hour layout including linen choices, glassware choices, etc... We go over all vendor selections (or help select vendors), and in general, just spend some time getting to know you and your overall vision a little better. We feel strongly that your day should be a reflection of YOU, and we work very hard to help make YOUR vision become a reality.

-Meeting 2: Your second meeting takes place 3 months prior to your wedding date. At this meeting we revisit all selections and layout from first meeting and make any necessary changes. We go through your ENTIRE wedding day (from arrival time to begin hair and makeup through the exit) in great detail. We take all info from this meeting and create a master timeline and processional and recessional. After this meeting we take over with all vendors in terms of details regarding load in and load out, items needed from the venue, etc...

-Rehearsal: Your coordinator will schedule, organize, and run your rehearsal.

-Day of Your Wedding: Your coordinator is onsite no less than 3 hours prior to ceremony start time and will remain onsite until you exit. We ensure that all the months of hard work and planning are executed seamlessly. We help place your last-minute items (guest book, items for unity ceremony, etc...), pin corsages and boutonnieres, keep track of time to ensure we remain on schedule, send everyone down the aisle and back, and oversee the entire reception.

We are always available by phone, email, or text and are happy to guide you through the whole process from start to finish.

Bar

You may bring in your own alcohol. Obtaining a day of event insurance policy will be required. We have partnered with a company called Nuptial to make the process a breeze. Once you book, we will set you up with Nuptial. Adding on the bar package is necessary if you are having alcohol. Please drop off alcohol to us no later than 9:30 am the day of your event so that our staff can begin getting it sorted, cold, and set up for your reception.

Bar Package: \$400.00

Includes:

- 1 Bartender
- Chilling all alcohol
- Set up of 2 bars (Cocktail Hour Bar and Reception Bar)
- Clear disposable tumblers for cocktails, wine glasses for wine, white cocktail napkins, stir straws, ice, and bar tools
- Break down, clean up, and boxing up unused items

Additional Bartender: \$200.00 - Additional bartender *may* be required for more than 200 guests OR if you are serving cocktails



We believe your big day should be a reflection of YOU. For that reason, you may bring in any outside vendors of your choice. We do have a preferred vendor list with some amazing vendors in a wide range of pricing and style that we can guide you through. We love helping your vision become a reality!

ADD ON OPTIONS

- 201-250 Guests: \$500.00 additional charge for extra set up, event, and break down staff
- 251-300 Guests: \$1,000.00 additional charge for extra set up, event, and break down staff
- 301-400 guests: \$2,000.00 additional charge for extra set up, event, and break down staff
- Glass Dinnerware Package: white porcelain dinner plate, silverware, iced tea/water glasses and disposable napkin (includes extra staff to set tables, bus tables, and wash dishes)



FAQ's

• How many guests can Grant Hill Farms accommodate?

Our packages are based on up to 200 guests. We can accommodate up to 300 guests for an indoor/outdoor reception. Renting additional chairs for ceremony will be necessary with more than 225 guests in attendance

• How much is the deposit, when is it due, and is it refundable?

A \$1,000.00 nonrefundable deposit is required to firmly hold your date. 50% of the remaining balance is due halfway between the time of booking and the wedding date. The remainder is due 3 months prior to your wedding date. Should you choose to cancel your wedding date, anything paid up to the time of cancelation is nonrefundable

DO YOU OFFER A MILITARY DISCOUNT?

YES! We offer a 10% <u>active duty</u> military discount. The 10% is taken off of the venue pricing. Thank you for your service!

WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT DO YOU ACCEPT?

Our listed pricing reflects a 3% cash or check discount. We do accept most major credit cards; however, the 3% discount would be added back to your payment. We also accept Zelle payments.

• Are we required to use certain vendors at Grant Hill Farms?

You may bring in any outside vendors of your choice with no penalty fee, however, we do have a lengthy list of amazing preferred vendors in each category.

• IS THERE AN INSURANCE POLICY WE MUST PURCHASE?

Yes. Purchasing a day of event insurance policy is necessary for all events. We work with a wonderful company called Nuptial who has made this process a breeze. Once you book, we will set you up with them. Cost is around \$220.00.

• CAN THE VENUE ACCOMMODATE A BAND OR DJ?

We can accommodate both a band or a DJ. While we can provide tables, linens, and power, the DJ or band is responsible for bringing in their own sound equipment.

• Are real candles permitted?

Yes! Open flame candles are permitted if they are in something to collect the wax. No taper candles please.

• Do you allow fireworks?

Fireworks are NOT permitted. Sparklers are fine.

• Are there areas for the bride and groom to change/get ready in?

Yes! There is a bridal suite as well as a groom's room for them to get ready in.

How many hours does our rental agreement include?

Access the morning of your wedding depends on what time hair and makeup artist will need to begin (your coordinator will work with photographer, hair, and makeup vendors to help determine this time). Reception must end by 11:00 pm.

• Do you have an inclement weather plan?

Yes! We have two outdoor ceremony locations. One is in an open field. The other is under a 4,000 sq ft covered pavilion. We can also accommodate an indoor ceremony.

• IS THE RECEPTION SPACE CLIMATE CONTROLLED?

Yes! We do have both heat and air conditioning

• WHEN WILL REHEARSAL MY BE HELD?

Your one-hour rehearsal will be held the week of your wedding. The date and time of rehearsal will be based upon Grant Hill Farms schedule. Your time will be scheduled firmly 3 months prior to your wedding day.

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
