Wedding Planner

An approved professional Wedding Planner is required for your wedding to assist you with the rehearsal, ceremony, reception and overall wedding planning. The Wedding Planner should also oversee the following:

- Create a timeline and diagrams for your entire wedding day, including the ceremony and reception.
- Work with you to organize and coordinate your ceremony rehearsal.
- Confirm details with any contracted vendors, prior to the wedding day.
- Act as the liaison between your family, bridal party, vendors and hotel associates.
- Deliver and setup all floral arrangements, décor, client arranged rental items, ceremony programs, place cards, favors and personal items.
- Coordinate timing of ceremony and reception (i.e. cueing music, grand entrance, toasts, cake cutting, first dance, etc.)

Picturesque location along the pristine bluffside. Trademark gazebo perched perfectly in the background. Carousel Lawn offers the perfect intimate setting for an event.

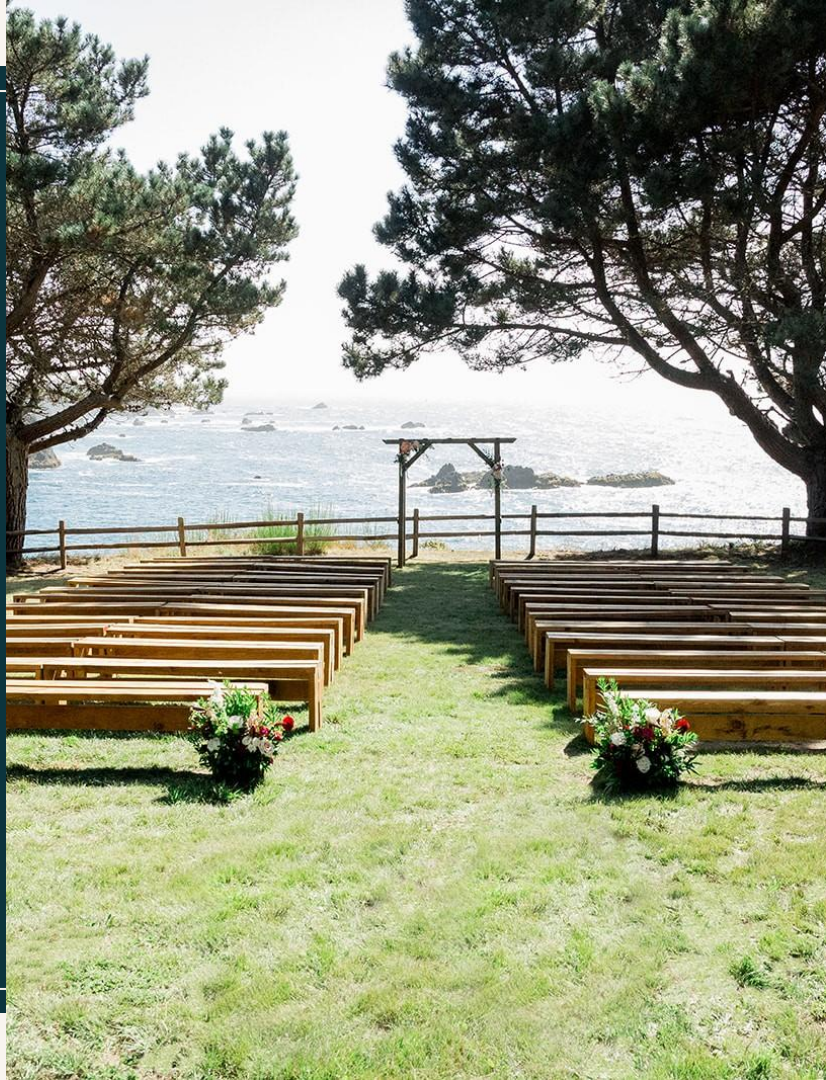
Accommodates up to 100 guests.

Accommodates up to 140 guests.



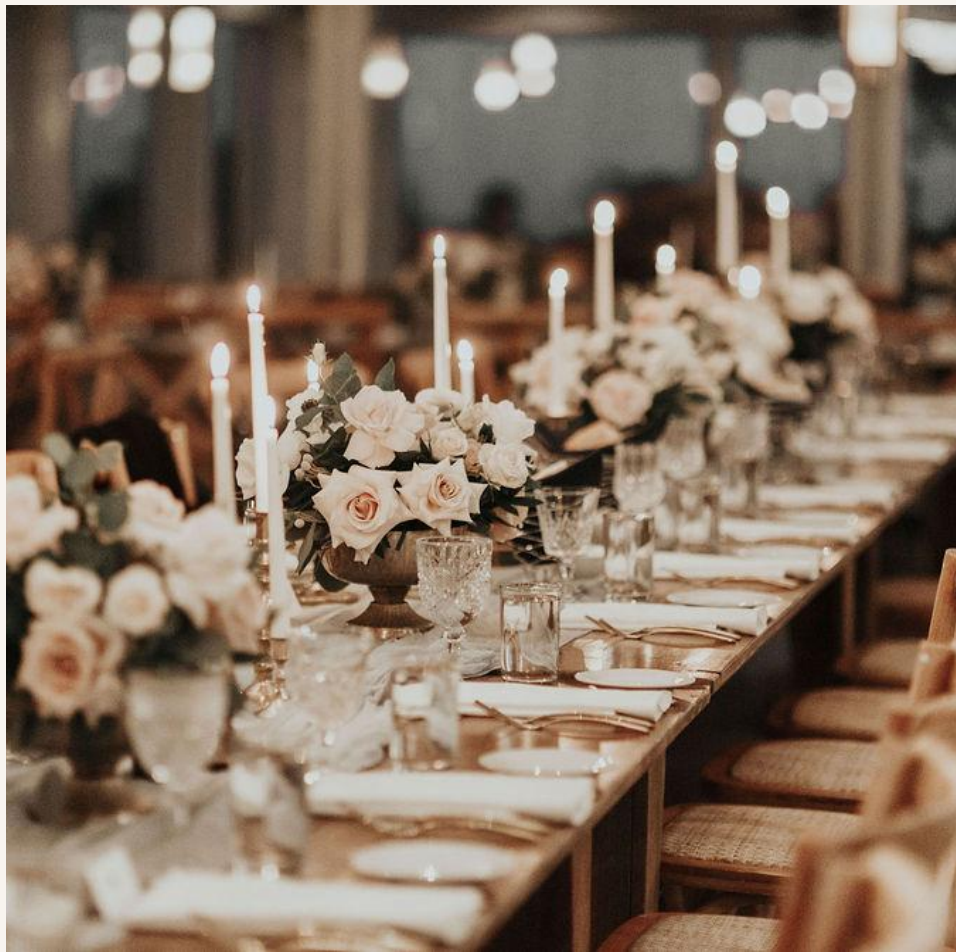


Same Time, Next Year Meadow

Lower Dining Room

Silver | \$125 per person

- Cocktail reception with 3 appetizers - passed or on platters for 1 hour
- 2 course dinner - soup or salad, bread, choice of 3 entrees
- Cake table, cake cutting and plating fee included
- Up to 3 vendor meals included. Additional vendors \$65 each.

Gold | \$155 per person

- Cocktail reception with 4 appetizers - passed or on platters for 1 hour
- 3 course dinner - soup, salad, bread, choice of 3 upgraded entrees
- Cake table, cake cutting and plating fee included
- Up to 5 vendor meals included. Additional vendors \$75 each.

Platinum | \$175 per person

- Cocktail reception with 6 appetizers - passed or on platters for 1 hour
- 3 course dinner - soup, salad, bread, choice of 3 premium entrees
- Late night fare
- Cake table, cake cutting and plating fee included
- Up to 7 vendor meals included. Additional vendors \$85 each.





Beverage Packages

Silver | \$50 per person

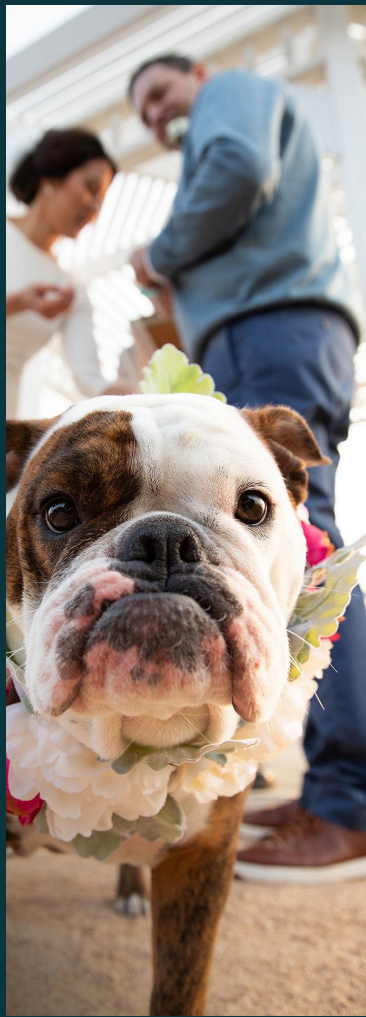
- Beer: choice of 1 bottled beer, 2 draft
- Wine: one red, one white, one sparkling
- Liquor: house vodka, gin, tequila, bourbon, rum
- \$15 per person per hour after 4 hours

Gold | \$60 per person

- Beer: choice of 2 bottled beer, 4 draft
- Wine: two reds, two whites, one sparkling
- Liquor: mid-tier vodka, gin, tequila, bourbon, rum
- \$20 per person per hour after 4 hours

Platinum | \$70 per person

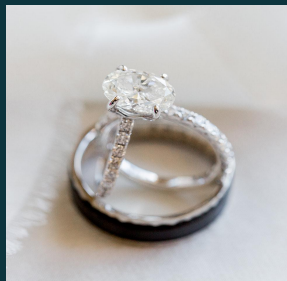
- Beer: choice of 2 bottled beer, 6 draft
- Wine: two reds, two whites, one rose, one sparkling
- Liquor: Premium vodka, gin, tequila, bourbon, rum
- \$25 per person per hour after 4 hours



Policies and Additional Information:

- *All rates and fees are subject to applicable taxes.*
- *A gratuity of 22% will be added to all food and beverage packages. Tax, gratuities, and fees do not count towards minimum spend requirements.*
- *A non-refundable 50% advanced deposit equal to 50% of the site fee is due at contract signing.*
- *Exclusivity of use of the facility not guaranteed unless there is a full property buyout.*
- *Final guest count and meal selections are required fourteen (14) days prior to the first day of the event. Any changes made within the fourteen (14) days leading up to the first day of the event must be approved by The Heritage House Resort & Spa and may be subject to additional costs.*
- *The client is responsible to hire a professional wedding planner and day of coordinator for all events above 24 guests. The Heritage House Resort & Spa must express written approval for the client's choice of a wedding planner no more than thirty (30) upon finalized contract.*
- *No outside décor, music, food or beverage shall be brought in without the express written approval of The Heritage House Resort & Spa, with the exception of the wedding cake. Wine and beverages are subject to change based on availability at the time of the event.*
- *Events over 90 guests require a property buyout of all 59 guest rooms and a two-night minimum.*
- *In the event of inclement weather, a tent may be required for the ceremony site at the client's expense.*
- *All outside vendors must provide proof of insurance coverage naming The Heritage House Resort & Spa as additionally insured. All documents must be provided to the property at least 48-hours before any work is performed on site.*
- *All vendors, setups and items not under the scope of control of The Heritage House Resort & Spa require express written approval before any work is performed on site. The Heritage House Resort & Spa reserves the right to restrict, forbid, and/or control activities that are dangerous, unlawful or do not align with the character of the property.*
- *Outside vendors are responsible for their own set-up and clean-up. Vendors may not consume alcohol while on property.*





Policies and Additional Information (continued):

- *For non-property buyouts, all events must conclude no later than 10:00pm in consideration for other hotel guests. For property buyouts, all events must conclude no later than 11:59pm. Any exceptions are subject to the express written approval from The Heritage House Resort & Spa.*
- *In consideration for other hotel guests, The Heritage House Resort & Spa may require specific rooms to be rented to alleviate noise disturbances. The number of rooms and their locations are subject to the reception site(s).*
- *The Heritage House Resort & Spa is not responsible for damage or loss of any rental equipment.*
- *No fires, sparklers, open flames, or smoking on property permitted without the express written approval from The Heritage House Resort & Spa. Any exceptions granted must include a fire suppression plan.*
- *We require the client to pay any and all damages incurred as a result of your guests or vendors, including excess damage to the grounds, rental equipment or gardens as well as loss of lodging revenue as a direct result of the actions of your guests or vendors.*
- *The Heritage House Resort & Spa reserves the right to restrict the sale or refuse service of alcohol to any guests including, but not limited to, those who have over-consumed are showing symptoms of intoxication, become excessively rowdy or unruly, or harassing associates or other individuals.*
- *All pricing provided is for quote-purposes only and is subject to change until we have completed a contract and accepted your deposit to reserve your dates. The Heritage House Resort & Spa reserves the right to adjusting pricing based on unforeseen circumstances or make appropriate substitutions, with written notice to the client.*
