Wedding services offered at Grand Targhee Resort for the 2024 Summer Season from June 18, 2024 – September 17, 2024.

### WELCOME RECEPTION

OR REHEARSAL DINNER

A family-friendly, mountain-casual atmosphere with indoor and outdoor seating; ideal for welcoming all your guests. You will have the option to host yard games or provide a cash bar, both popular ways to kick off the festivities. Menu options feature authentic Rocky Mountain fare with fresh, local ingredients and Wyoming-raised beef. An expansive wine list is available with selections to complement a range of foods. The full bar serves liquor, local micro brews on tap, specialty cocktails, and wines by the glass.

+ Site Fee: \$300. Additional catering order required. Minimum of 35 guests.

### WEDDING CEREMONY

TEEWINOT LAWN

Your ceremony will be held on the lawn located next to the Teewinot deck, above the Aspen Meadow Pavilion. With the iconic Peaked Mountain as a backdrop, the Teewinot lawn is surrounded by groves of aspens and wildflowers. This site includes wedding arbor/arch, sitting, and a PA system. Rest assured; we also offer a backup ceremony site option in the event of unexpected, inclement weather.

### COCKTAIL HOUR

TEEWINOT DECK

Toast to a lifetime of happiness with your loved ones. Our Teewinot Deck can be set up for a Cocktail Hour after the ceremony. Guests may mingle and get to know each other or catch up over a few drinks and hors d'oeuvres. The deck sits between the conference space, dressing room and the Teewinot lawn, making it the perfect location for the wedding party to quickly freshen up and get ready for some post ceremony photos.

### THE RECEPTION

**ASPEN MEADOWS PAVILION** 

Our spacious 40' x 100' Aspen Meadows Pavilion Tent is nestled in the forest, creating an intimate outdoor ambiance in the mountains while allowing an intimate environment to be shared by your guests on your special day. Located just steps from our mountain lodging, the reception site is perfect for guests staying at the resort. The reception site comes complete with a dance floor, stage, lights, restrooms, tables, chairs, linens, and table wares as needed to execute your event. A fire pit completes the outdoors romantic feel where we can set up a S'mores service.

+ Maximum capacity is 200 guests. Service time is 4 hours, ending at 10:00pm, with a catering minimum of \$75 per person.



# AFTER PARTY TRAP BAR & GRILL

Keep the celebration going late into the night after your dinner service has concluded. At 10pm, continue celebrating with your family and friends at your personal late night after party. Our Trap Bar will offer all you need to dance and share this special time until 1am.

+ Site Fee: \$300. Additional \$200 bar tab minimum required. Available from 10pm to 1am.

### LODGING

SLOPESIDE LODGING

Spend your Wedding Night at Grand Targhee Resort and enjoy the beautiful atmosphere and relaxed vibe of the mountains while you take the first steps as a married couple. Grand Targhee resort also offers a lodging discount to your wedding guests in the Teewinot Lodge, Sioux Lodge and Tower Suite.

A discounted group reservation block comes as part of your event contract. There is no responsibility held to the couple and lodging blocks are released 90 days prior to the event. Your Wedding night will be booked at the time your contract is signed and you may add additional nights at the group discounted rate.

+ All reservations will be subject to a minimum length of stay. We strongly recommend wedding guests to arrive a day in advance to be able to enjoy the resort and have available lodgings to get ready in time for the ceremony. Early check-ins are not guaranteed and seldom available during peak times, additional charges may apply.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

Airport transportation is available for guests at either the Jackson Hole Airport or the Idaho Falls Airport. Guests can book their transportation through the reservations department. If you need private transportation for airport transfers or off-site activities or events, we can curate a custom quote.

### YOGA

#### PRIVATE YOGA

Start the "Best Day Ever" energized with an open mind and calm spirit. Focus on attitude and alignment through movement and breath. ### SUMMIT PRIVATE YOGA

Ride Dreamcatcher to the Fred's Mountain summit. Revitalize your senses with the fresh mountain air and take in the stunning Teton views. Enjoy a yoga session focused on centering the mind through a graceful flow. Take the scenic chair lift down for final moments of calm and beautiful scenery or hike down with your group. All levels welcome.

## **FAQS**

Is brunch available on our departure day?

A morning after brunch is a great way to keep the celebration going and say goodbye before guests head back home. Our brunches are usually casual, giving guests a time range to stop by (i.e.: 8:30am to 10:30am). Guests can show up once they're ready to depart to enjoy something to eat before they leave. This gives you a few more hours surrounded by those closest to you. We may customize the menu to fit your needs. Let's discuss what you two have in mind.

What will the weather be like on our wedding date?

June is great for snowcapped peaks. July and August are ideal for wildflowers. September provides fall colors. In case of inclement weather, there is always the option of a "delay of game". Mountain weather tends to move quickly and there is the option to delay the ceremony while weather passes. If it is decided to move the ceremony location, we offer the Aspen Meadow Pavilion as it would already be decorated for the reception.

Can we go up the lift for views of the Tetons?

Lift tickets included in the package are for the couple and the bridal party (up to 20). If you would like to purchase additional tickets for the group, we provide discounted group rates. Going to the summit for photographs will be added to your timeline and coordinated with the event manager and your photographer.

How should we budget for the bar?

We recommend budgeting two drinks per person, knowing that some guest will drink less than others. We charge beverages based on consumption and we offer multiple bar tiers (well, middle, and top shelf). Bar payments can be planned however you prefer, cash vs. open, beer vs. wine, etc.



Does Grand Targhee Resort have décor we can use?

We have limited décor on hand to accent your own theme and decorations. Grand Targhee Resort's items include burlap runners, mason jars, chalk boards, signs, wood stump pieces, and more. Our event manager will send you a list with available items once planning begins.

Can we open the tent flaps in the Pavilion?

The Aspen Meadow Pavilion tent flaps open with two main entrances. The main entrance is on the West side near the fire pit and bar while the second is on the North side (service entrance). All the tied flaps on the sides of the tent can be opened upon request. Nights in the mountains can be chilly, therefore we provide standing heaters for the evenings if needed. As your event draws closer, we may discuss your needs based on weather predictions.

Can we bring in our own catering or bar services?

Grand Targhee provides full catering and bar services, outside catering and beverages are not permitted. Our food & beverage minimum of \$75/person++ is very attainable and we are happy to work with your favorite food and dietary requests. If you cannot find what you are looking for in our current menu offer, we may discuss your personal catering needs.

What are the guest minimums listed per event day site fees?

Since our Wedding season is very short, we require a minimum number of guests to reserve a wedding. If you are concerned about your guest list, let us know and we will be happy to discuss options and possibilities. Additionally, our catering services require a minimum of 35 to 80 guests depending on the service. While you can have smaller, more intimate events, the final cost will be determined by the service minimums. We can provide an invoice calculator so that you can budget your wedding ahead of time.

What are the next steps to book your event?

To confirm your date and venue, a contract is created. We will require the following information to set it up: contact information for both partners, confirmed wedding date, number of guests, additional venues reserved (welcome reception, late night) if any, estimated number of lodging units (we will calculate final number). A non-refundable deposit will be charged at the time the contract is signed; this may equate up to 50% of site fee. The remaining balance will be due 180 days prior to your event. The lodging block reserved will be released 90 days prior to your event. Once the contract is signed and deposit collected, you will be introduced to our events manager and a suggested vendor list will be provided. The Events Manager will create your Wedding Itinerary where you will share all the information and details needed to organize the wedding.
