


## Hey there, cutie pies.

## I'm here to turn your wedding dreams into lifetime memories.


(AND TO MAKE SURE YOU LOOK LIKE A MILLION BUCKS WHILE DOING IT)








I'm known to make friends quickly, but be careful!! By the end of your day I just might just be making dinner plans with your grandparents or dancing with your nieces!

I'm sure you still have questions, so let's do this!

You can count on at least 50 images per hour of wedding-day coverage. Odds are that you'll receive more than this (because epic celebrations deserve allIII the photos!), but this is the absolute, bare-bones minimum that I deliver.

I capture a mixture of posed and candid photos throughout the day, but I always take the reins on posing your portraits, your family formals, and your bridal party. Oh, and don't worry! I'll tell you where to put your hands! (The default is generally on your partner's butt, just so you know.)

I'll also deliver about 10% of your gallery as copies in black and white. I'll make those selections from your final gallery, but if you see a shot you absolutely need in black and white, just ask!



## Mext's next?

Here's the sitch. To book your day on my calendar, I require two things – a signed contract and a \$500 non-refundable retainer.

Let me know the package you prefer and I'll get the ball rolling with the contract!

Return the signed contract with your wedding date and package details.

Send over the \$500 retainer via Zelle, Venmo, or credit card.

Once I recieve the signed contract and retainer, you're officially booked!

Your wedding coverage will be due in stages, with the final payment due 30 days before your wedding date. Don't worry, I'll send you the schedule and email reminders!

We'll plan and shoot your engagement session. I'll have the session delivered in 3-4 weeks for you to use for invitations, guest books, car magnets, oversized throw blankets, etc.

The week before your wedding we'll do a final consultation to walk through your timeline and make sure we're all on the same page.
