Thank you for taking the time to learn more about us, and consider using DJ Flair for your wedding. We are honored to be in consideration and would love an opportunity to earn your business. When chosen as your DJ, we promise to work with all parties involved – the planner, the caterer, photographer, etc. – to ensure your evening flows without problems. We also work hand-in-hand with you throughout the wedding, should you have any concerns. You set the limits, we'll set the mood.

DJ rates can vary based on a number of factors including talent, experience, emcee (microphone) ability, service, coordination talents, equipment used, musical knowledge, mixing ability – the list really could go on. These rates range from a low around \$200 to upwards of \$5,000 with the average wedding DJ costing \$1,500 nationwide for a 4 hour wedding. The best price is not always the best deal.

With the advent of technology, becoming a DJ is easier than ever, and talent, experience and knowledge are at a premium. Major institutions are aware of this – and its one reason we are on many venue's preferred vendor list as one of their "go-to" DJ service companies. Experience is valuable and worth paying for, and surveys conclude that nearly 100% of brides would have spent more money on their DJ and made it their #1 priority being hindsight. A full service DJ would normally invest up to 30 hours to specialize and fine tune your event, but it may appear that you are only paying for "4 hours." Consultations, music purchases and editing, paperwork prep, legal fees, set up, tear down, logistics and travel, continuing education and other business related endeavors are covered in your contracted price outside the stated obvious items. All of these add up to the success of your wedding.

Mock Timeline 6 Hour Wedding



• Ceremony	1 hour
• Prelude (guest arrival)	
• Family, Groomsmen, Bridal Party and Bridal Entrance Songs	
• Exit song	
• Cocktail Hour	1 hour
• Genre based music mix (Jazz, Instrumental, Love, Pop)	
• DJ Introduces Himself To Crowd	5 mins
• Recognize honored guests	
• Advise guests of timeline and “need to know items”	
• Introduction of Wedding Party	5 minutes
• Song picked out on our website for your big entrance	
• First Dance	5 minutes
• Sometimes this is done after dinner	
• Inform your DJ if you prefer the song cut short	
• Cake Cutting	5 minutes
• Done early if you have a cake that may melt	
• Welcome	5 minutes
• Father of The Bride	
• Blessing	5 minutes
• Pastor, or family friend	
• Dinner	1 hour

Next Steps To Book DJ Flair



- A contract is due within 2 weeks of receiving a quote, and your date will be released if no contract is received
- Contracts will be emailed to the responsible party, and must be signed and mailed or dropped at the office to confirm booking

- Wedding booking requires a \$300 non-refundable deposit
 - Check or cash preferred
 - Make checks payable to “Flair Entertainment”
- Credit Card Payments will be handled via PayPal Invoicing and will be emailed to the responsible party
 - Credit card payments carry a 5% additional fee
 - This is a “pass through” charge by the credit card processor
- We also accept PayPal, Venmo and Zelle payments
- Final balance is due 2 weeks before the event date
 - Additional payments can be made in advance – please inform us so we can make sure not to miss
