## THE CHURCH

A fter decades of rest, the great hall of Sts. Peter & Paul has been lovingly restored with careful attention. Built in 1861, every pane of stained glass is infused with history and every brick with stories of days past. The reverberant and resonant hall is located squarely in the Faubourg Marigny, the city's eclectic hub for art, cuisine, and entertainment and only a short walk from the French Quarter. The church has served as a haven and gathering place for over for a century and a half, and now, we open her doors to you and yours.

#### **EVENT TIMES**

Access to the space for a ceremony & reception includes a 4 hour event. Load-in starts at noon the day of the event for preparation, photos, and vendors.

Due to the noise ordinance in our residential neighborhood, all events must end by 10:00 PM, with load-out complete two hours after the event ends.

- Utilities including electricity, A/C or heat & wifi.
- Men's and women's restrooms, fully stocked with proper amenities including custom hand soap & lotion.

#### **VENUE FEES - RECEPTION ONLY**

#### ADDITIONAL FEES

Ceremony (+1 hr)...... \$2,000 Includes use of the piazza during the flip Additional Hour (earlier only)......\$2,000

#### VARIABLE PRICING

- For Friday dates, subtract \$2,000 from the above price.
- For Sunday-Thursday dates, subtract \$3,000 from the above price.

• For Saturday dates in July and August, subtract \$2,000 from the above price. Weekday weddings in our low season are eligible for further discounts.

• For additional hours on the front end, add \$2,000 per hour.

• We charge an additional \$100 per hour cleaning fee and \$50 per hour for on-site security.



#### CEREMONY-ONLY



\*These prices are for Saturdays, holidays and holiday weekends.

We will only consider booking ceremony-only events on Saturdays in March, April, October and November within 12 months of the event date. Access is permitted 3 hours before the ceremony and 1 hour after for preparation, photos, vendors and breakdown.

#### ELOPEMENTS & MICRO-WEDDINGS

Elopements and micro-weddings for weekend dates can only be booked within 6 months of the event date. Weekday events can be booked within 12 months. General availability: Tuesdays through Fridays before 5pm. Saturdays before noon. Sundays and Mondays all day.

## COCKTAILS

Our piazza is nestled between the School House and Rectory and is available to use for a 45-minute cocktail hour between your ceremony and reception. It's a lovely place to have drinks, bound by greenery and historic buildings on either side. If you plan to use the piazza, the 6 guest rooms adjacent to it will need to be rented as part of your group block.







#### SAVE THE DATE

To secure your date, we require a signed contract and a 50% non-refundable deposit. We are not able to soft hold dates for the church.

#### ACCOMODATIONS

We offer 71 hotel rooms across three historic buildings. Like the classrooms and congregations before us, Hotel Peter & Paul has several areas that were designed with community and camaraderie in mind. There are four rooms tucked backstage behind the School House theater, five rooms above the rectory parlors with plush and romantic finishings, and seven rooms meant for contemplation and respite in the convent. Specializing in old-world wines that suit every palate to local brews and non-alcoholic options, they're here by our side with unmatched spirit and expertise, shaker in hand. We are able to host a bar package, host alcohol charged on consumption, or host a cash bar, which is subject to a minimum, and can also discuss extra premium packages for the finest drops.

Bacchanal can offer a customizable menu for many gatherings. With regional ingredients and selections and set-ups ranging from passed hors d'oeuvres to seated dinners - we're here to suit your ideal evening. Adding additional hours and combining options can be be discussed and menu options are available upon request.











## QUESTIONS WE ARE FREQUENTLY ASKED

#### How can I arrange a viewing of the church and rooms?

We would love to share the space with you so you have the best idea of what we offer and how we can make your wedding day one to remember - please begin the conversation by filling out our inquiry form <u>here</u>.

#### What is included with the rental of the church?

The rental fee includes use of the space and facilities and does not include decorations, china, silverware, glassware, linens, catering, tables, or staffing.

#### What are my options for payment?

For event rental, 50% of the total cost is due as a non-refundable deposit by check or cash at the time of booking and the remaining 50% plus a \$1,500 security deposit is due 30 days prior to the event. This \$1,500 security deposit is returned upon completion of the event after a site inspection. For catering, a 50% deposit via check or credit card on file is required to confirm and hold the package and the balance is due in full at the close of the event.

#### Is parking included?

Although the hotel has a parking lot, it is not large enough to accommodate non-hotel guests, and street parking is hard to come by (vendors may park in our lot). We suggest that clients procure a Lyft or Uber code for their guests to eliminate parking needs. We can help you arrange for a valet service or nearby off-site parking to rent.

#### Are DJs and live bands allowed and is there a noise limit?

DJs and live bands are allowed but noise is never to exceed 85 decibels.

#### Do you allow second lines?

Due to an agreement with our neighbors, second lines are not permitted.

#### Can I add or subtract from my final guest count?

A guaranteed guest count is required three days prior to event date, and we reserve the right to bill for any guest count increase.

#### Should I hire a wedding planner?

Yes, we require hiring a coordinator or planner to help you plan your celebration and can recommend the best in town.

#### What is the cancellation policy?

We are happy to accommodate date changes, pending availability. We do not offer refunds for event space cancellations.

#### Can I use a custom menu and drink program?

Suggested menus simply act as a guideline in creating your special event. Bacchanal takes great pride in customizing each menu to fit the needs of your group. Outside food and beverages are not allowed into the event space.

#### Can I bring my own beverages or use an outside caterer?

A \$20.00 per 750ml bottle charge for all alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages will apply to beverages not purchased through Bacchanal. Outside caterers are not allowed.

#### What are taxes, service charges, and additional fees?

Guestroom taxes are 16.2% plus \$1.00 occupancy fee per night. Food and beverage taxes are 10.25%. Food and beverage service charge is 20%. We charge \$100 per hour as a cleaning fee and \$50 per hour for security. Cake cutting fee is \$2 per slice, with a maximum \$200 charge.
