Engagements session are fire. These are the photos that you will be using to tell the freaking world you are GETTING MARRIED!!

Let me help you with when, where, and how to book this session. Depending on your package, your engagement session may be included in your pricing. Ask your photographer about this.

If you book one with me, I will send you my outfit guide to help you. Because let's face it, we all stress about our outfits, especially if there is a camera involved.

I will also provide a list of recommended locations (depending on your area/location). But just because it's on my list does not mean you have to choose it.

# SESSION TIPS CONTINUED

Timing is everything

Timing is everything! So when do you need to schedule these? If you want to use them for your save the dates or invitations you might want to make this a priority in the beginning. Aim to get this done eight to six months before your big day. Make sure to talk to your photographer about their turnaround time to make sure you get them in time.

Regarding the time of day, if you leave this up to your photographer they will choose sunrise or sunset. So make sure you actually tell them what works for you. But with that said, diffused light (overcast) or when the sun is low on the horizon is the best kind of light. Harsh mid-day sun is the WORST! But that's just my opinion.
