- The Boathouse is open to the public during select periods. Available dates and times may vary accordingly.
- Fees cover an eight-hour rental, including two hours for vendor load-in and set-up, and one hour for vendor break-down and load-out.
- Overtime can be purchased for \$500 per hour, up to three additional hours.
- Events may not run past 12:00 a.m.
- Parking lot for up to 30 vehicles, with additional permitted access to drive directly to the Boathouse for vendors and load-in.
- Fees include a one-year membership to the Prospect Park Alliance.




















Directions

Enter Prospect Park just south of 452 Flatbush.

Q, S, or B trains to Prospect Park Station

Follow the sign for the Flatbush Ave./Ocean Ave. southwest corner exit.

Turn left and walk towards the traffic light at Ocean Ave.

Cross the street to Prospect Park.

Turn left into the brick-paved Park entrance (Willink Drive). Staff will direct you to the Boathouse.

From Manhattan via Manhattan Bridge

Proceed on Flatbush Avenue approximately two miles to Grand Army Plaza.

Proceed halfway around the traffic circle to continue on Flatbush Ave (Botanic Garden on left, Park on right). Just after passing the Zoo and Lefferts Historic House on the right, make a right turn into the brick paved Park entrance: Willink Drive, one hundred feet before the traffic light at the intersection of Empire Blvd and Ocean Ave.

Staff will direct you where to park. From there it is a short walk to the Boathouse.

From Long Island via BQE West

Exit at Tillary Street and make a left turn at onto Flatbush Avenue. Proceed as above: From Manhattan via Manhattan Bridge.

From Staten Island via Verrazano Bridge

Follow the Brooklyn Queens Expressway East. Exit at Atlantic Avenue and make a right turn onto Flatbush Avenue. Continue approximately one mile to Grand Army Plaza. Proceed as above: From Manhattan via Manhattan Bridge.
