

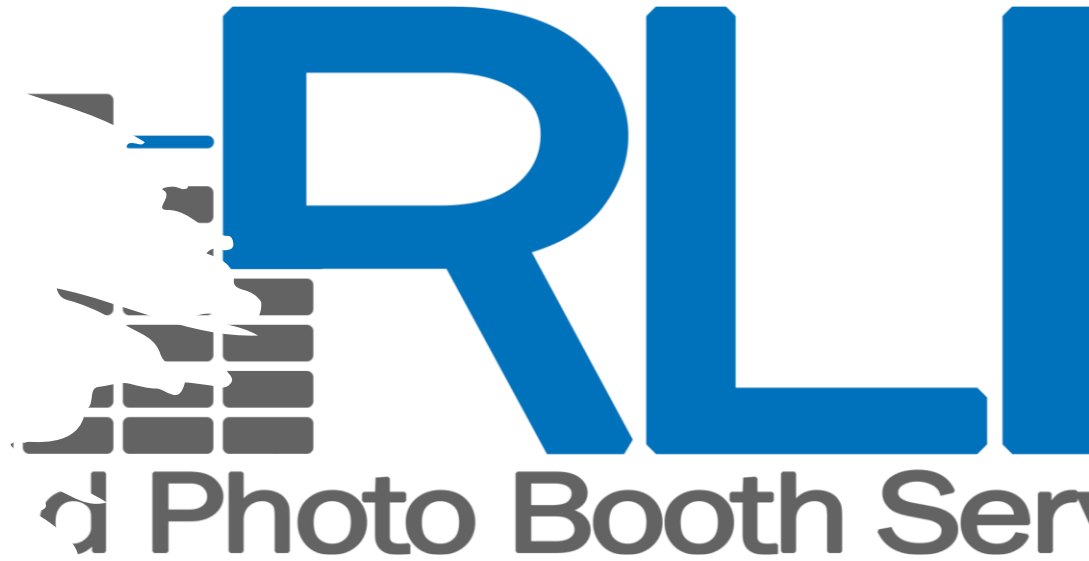


WEDDING PACKAGES 2022

Popular Add-ons

Up Lighting

This is by far the most popular add-on to any wedding package. Up lights can transform any room into a single or multiple colors to match the theme of your wedding.

The lights can create almost any color by using red, green, blue, amber, white and Ultra Violet LEDs including pastels and bright colors such as hot pinks and blues. They are battery powered so can be placed anywhere within a room without cables. Different lenses are available to adjust the spread of the beam from a frost to a 110 or 10 degree angle.

All the lighting is intelligent, meaning it can be controlled wirelessly and adjusted to suit the mood so when the time comes for dancing, they can be placed into music mode to create energy within the room. The patterns, colors and speed can all be adjusted to suit the music, so the lighting won't be going crazy for those intimate moments.



Lighting

Dance Floor Lighting

Like the up lights, these are also intelligent and work in conjunction with other lighting.

The **basic package** consists of 4 static lights on a T-bar which can create any color and provide a wash effect for the dancefloor or other parts of the room.

For larger rooms, moving heads are available. These are the latest lighting technology and are typically used at concerts and night clubs. These can produce several colors, patterns and can be controlled to project the beam anywhere, ceiling, walls or dancefloor and can be programmed to move the beam during dancing or any other occasion such as highlighting the grand entrance.

Full color lasers and haze (better than smoke) are available to enhance all the lighting.





Sound

The speakers play a very important part, at the ceremony and the reception so it's important they sound good. QSC manufacture some of the best speakers, and are modular, meaning just the top cabinets can be used for smaller rooms up to about 150 people then subs can be added for that extra low-end punch for larger events. The full system outputs a whopping 8000 watts!

Microphones are just as important as the speakers and 2 wireless handhelds, and 1 lapel microphone are available for use.

Hooking everything together is the mixing board. Again, various configurations are available depending on requirements, from a compact Native Instruments controller up to a full Pioneer CDJ club system. No matter what is used, there are backups of everything, so in the event of an equipment malfunction, the show goes on.

All the music is all stored on a laptop (with several backups) and streaming services such as Spotify are never used. What if the internet was to go down during your first dance? Some DJs do stream music – be warned!

A La Carte Pricing

Packages aren't your thing? No problem! Try our a la carte menu!

- DJ Rate: \$1100 for 4 hours - This is the base rate.
- Overtime Rate: \$275 per hour
- Ceremony Audio: \$375 This includes a separate sound system, 1 custom song edit and 2 wireless microphones.
- Up lighting: \$30/light which can be positioned anywhere to create any color. \$300 for 12
- Monogram Projection: \$250 Project your custom image anywhere
- Custom graphic for monogram: \$100
- Photo Booth: \$600 Digital media sharing and loaded with features
- Basic Dance Floor Lighting Package – 4 Fixtures \$150
- Intelligent Dance Floor Lighting Package – 4 Fixtures \$250
- Haze Machine: \$100 (Dependent on venue)
- 1W RGB Laser: \$100 (Requires Haze)
- Additional Speakers: \$100
- Custom Song Edit: \$50
- Travel: Standard mileage rates for one-way if more than 50 miles from our location.



Frequently Asked Questions



- 1. How long have you been DJing?** I have over 30 years of professional DJing experience and have performed at all types of events in different venues.
- 2. What type of equipment do you use?** I only use top of the line professional DJ equipment, most of which was updated in the last few years.
- 3. Do you have any backup plans if something goes wrong?** I always carry multiple backups of music should something fail.
- 4. Will I play requests?** I only take requests if you allow it. If allowed, I “filter” requests, meaning I will not play a song or a genre that you specifically asked me not to play. If someone makes a request that fits in well with what we’re playing at the time and with the music you want, then I will try and play it.
- 5. Can we request songs for the DJ to play?** You can pick which songs you want to hear, and ones you don’t want for your event.
- 6. Can we provide our own music for the DJ to play?** Sure, but I would like to get the music file(s) in advance of the event. If doing this, please consider the audience attending your event.
- 7. What are your payment terms?** The deposit is required at the time of booking and the remaining balance is due 2 weeks before the event.
- 8. Do I tip the DJ?** I do not include gratuity in the final contract price. 10-20% is generally recommended if you consider I did an awesome job, but it is entirely up to you. I am equipped with a card “swiper” and able to accept tips or additional payments at or after the event.
- 9. Will the DJ play overtime if needed?** Yes, I am able to play past the contracted time, but payment is due at that time if at all possible. I am equipped with a card “swiper” to accept payment for overtime.
- 10. When should we book a DJ?** A good time frame is at least six to twelve months out for a wedding. Less for other events. However, I am sometimes available for last minute events as well.
- 11. Should we feed the DJ?** This is not required in the contract and is completely up to you. Typically, the catering director or event coordinator will set aside a meal or boxed dinner for the DJ if requested by the client.
- 12. What other services do you offer?** I offer ceremony audio, sound systems, lighting (up lighting & dance floor lighting + lasers + haze (better than smoke) and photo booths. I also have a 140" screen and projector for sharing magical memories with friends or backyard movies.
- 13. How many songs should I request?** I would like for you to provide at least 15-20 songs of different genres and artists you would like to hear, as well as songs/artists you don’t so I have an idea of what music you’d like for the different parts of the event.
- 14. What do you wear when performing?** I always wear full suit and tie but feel free to inform me if your event has a theme and you’d like me to be a part of it!
