**Wedding Photography+ Engagement Session** .....\$2,850

**Wedding Photography + 40-Page Deluxe Album (10"x10")** .....\$3,200

**Wedding Photography + Engagement Session + Album** .....\$3,500

*Note: A 40-page wedding album can be substituted with two 20-page 9"x6" parent albums.*

### Engagement Sessions:

- 90 minutes of actual photography with two close locations and a wardrobe change.  
(Two 45-minute sessions not counting an outfit change break, and travel to second location.)
- Release form of ownership of all your proofs (typically 100-150 without duplicates).
- Edited favorites gallery.

### Deluxe Wedding Albums:

- 10"x10" or 12"x8" (40 pages) .....\$700
- 9"x6" Parent Albums (20 pages) .....\$350
- Includes thick pages with protective finish, metallic gloss or leather covers, and custom design.
- Ask about custom sizes/page counts, along with amenities such as metal covers and foil stamping.

### Prints and Wall Art:

A multitude of sizes, prints and products are available in your password-protected online lab.

\*From our years of experience, we have found that the vast majority of wedding day timelines require 10 hours (or loosely 9-11 hours) from getting-ready pictures to reception open dancing. In the beginning stages of wedding planning, it is often very confusing to determine the total photography hours needed, or your timeline is simply not established. Let us help you secure this. Unless you are having one of these three options, you will probably not need more than 9-11 hours of actual photography: **1. Morning church ceremony** (such as 11:00am). **2. Sparkler send-off** at the end of the evening. **3. You 100% want the last dance captured** because it will be something special. If one of these three options applies, let's talk about a timeline adjustment, or a reasonable rate to capture this extra time for you. If these options do not apply, trust us, 9-11 hours is ample.
