

Services and Pricing Guidelines for Floral Notes - Water, Wine and Champagne

Many variables go into pricing flowers. I divide them into 3 price points – water (i.e. daisy, carnations), wine (i.e. standard roses, hydrangeas, stock, lisianthus) and champagne (i.e. garden roses, dahlias, ranunculus). The quantity of each used determines the price. If you have champagne taste but not quite the champagne budget, I can strategically place the premium flowers to maximize their impact and visibility. Floral designers all have access to similar products – it's what I choose and what I do with it that sets Floral Notes apart.

Typical price for a **bridal bouquet** \$150.00+

Typical price for a **bridesmaid bouquet** \$85.00 - 100

Typical price for a **boutonniere** \$15.00

Typical price for a **low table arrangement** (per arrangement) \$90.00

Starting price for an **elevated table arrangement** (per arrangement) \$200.00

What can a customer expect to pay for wedding floral services? \$3000.00 includes bridal bouquet, 6 bridesmaids, 9 boutonnieres, 2 corsages, 15 centerpieces, and ceremony space with high quality flowers including strategically placed premium flowers such as garden roses.

Decrease this cost by using less expensive flowers, averaging centerpiece cost by having some centerpieces using rental items such as lanterns and creating smaller designs. Using top shelf flowers throughout the wedding will give a gorgeous, lush wedding with an increase in price. Do you have lots of bridesmaids? Smaller bouquets can be created to accommodate your budget. 5 Hour delivery & set-up fee and tax included.
