Helpful Tips:

Details help tell the story of your wedding and are often some of my clients' favorite images to include in albums & prints.

Gather all your details before the day starts so I can photograph them quickly! This makes the getting-ready portion of the day go by much more smoothly, and it allows me to spend more time focusing on the spontaneous moments when everyone is together.

Detail shot ideas: rings, jewelry, hair pieces, flowers, shoes, socks, cuff links, socks, letters, pictures, gifts, cultural items, invitations, programs, printed pieces, and any unique items you treasure!

YOU HAVE QUESTIONS

Q: What sets you apart from other photographers?

A: With a background in macro photography, I focus on all of the details that make your day extra special! Did you hand paint all of your centerpieces? Let me know! I want to capture each one for you - you worked hard on those!

Q: Will we get the print release to our photos after our wedding?

A: Yes! Upon receiving your images, you will also get a full print release.

Q: How many photographers will be there at our wedding?

A: All of my full service wedding collections come with two photographers to make sure no detail goes unnoticed!

Q: Will you Photoshop my images to hide any unwanted spots, wrinkles, etc?

A: Minor edits will be made to all of your images, but I believe our imperfections are what make us beautiful & unique. If there are specific edits you want, these will be charged accordingly, depending on the type of corrections.

Q: How long does it take to receive my online gallery?

A: Depending on the time of year and my calendar, it can take up to four weeks to receive your gallery. I do not rush through your images! If your collection comes with a custom USB, you can expect to receive that three weeks after receiving the online gallery.

I HAVE ANSWERS

Q: Do you offer albums?

A: Yes! I suggest a wedding album to all of my clients. You'll have it for generations to come. Working with two different companies, I am able to create an album to meet your own budget and quality needs.

Q: Do I have to order prints through you?

A: I highly recommend ordering prints through your online gallery! It is the only way I can guarantee print quality. My editing screens are calibrated with the printers at the professional lab. You may order prints from elsewhere with your Print Release, but I cannot guarantee print quality and will not edit images to match another printer.

Q: Do you photograph destination and out-of-town weddings?

A: Yes! I am happy to travel to you. Travel fees are based on mileage and moderate accommodations. Contact me for a quote!

Q: Will you be able to capture specific images for us?

A: Yes! We'll discuss must-have images, family groupings, and anything I should be aware of before your big day.

Q: How do we reserve our wedding date?

A: A 50% retainer and signed contract is required in order to get your wedding day on the calendar. The remainder of your balance is due two weeks prior to your wedding.

The First Look is my favorite part of a wedding day! Just the two of you - no audience, no distractions, and so many emotions. If it's something you're thinking about, I highly recommend it! We can even squeeze in wedding party and family photos before the ceremony to give you more time at your reception!



WHAT TO EXPECT

Getting Started

We'll spend some time together (virtually or in-person) so that I can learn all about your dreams and aspirations when it comes to your wedding photography!

Once we've decided we are a great fit for each other, I'll send over your contract and invoice.

Payment

A 50% non-refundable retainer is required in order to secure your date. The remaining 50% of your balance is due two weeks prior to your wedding day.



Plan Your Day

We'll work together to create a timeline to ensure your day goes as smoothly as possible. This is a great time to decide on things like a first look, must-have images, and anything else you may be unsure about.

Have a Pinterest board full of ideas?
We'll work to make them a reality!

Celebrate

I'll guide you through each step and make sure to keep it as stress-free on you as possible! I know you have a lot on your plate, so you can trust me to handle this so you can focus on your celebration.

HELPFUL TIPS

Before your engagement or bridal session, be sure to try on your wardrobe options to make sure they look & feel the way you want. While it is great to complement your future spouse in photos, by no means do you need to wear matching outfits. If you need some help, just ask!

Bring a few more accessories & outfits than you actually plan on wearing. It's always a good idea to have options.

If you're wondering what to wear on your wedding day before getting ready, wear something comfortable! You want to start off your day feeling relaxed. Coordinating robes are always a great idea, but if that's not quite your style, don't force it! It's your day - be yourself!

Tell me about all of the little touches you've added that truly make your wedding yours, and be sure to bring along any sentimental items you may want to incorporate into your images. I'll be sure to capture them for you!

Sometimes, things do not go as planned. Don't let any mishaps ruin your day. In the end, you'll remember the good parts and (probably) be able to laugh about anything that may have gone wrong!

Remember to relax & have fun! I'll take care of all the nitty-gritty details - sit back, & enjoy every moment!
