- Questionnaire

Each engaged couple is unique and the wedding they desire is just as unique as they are.

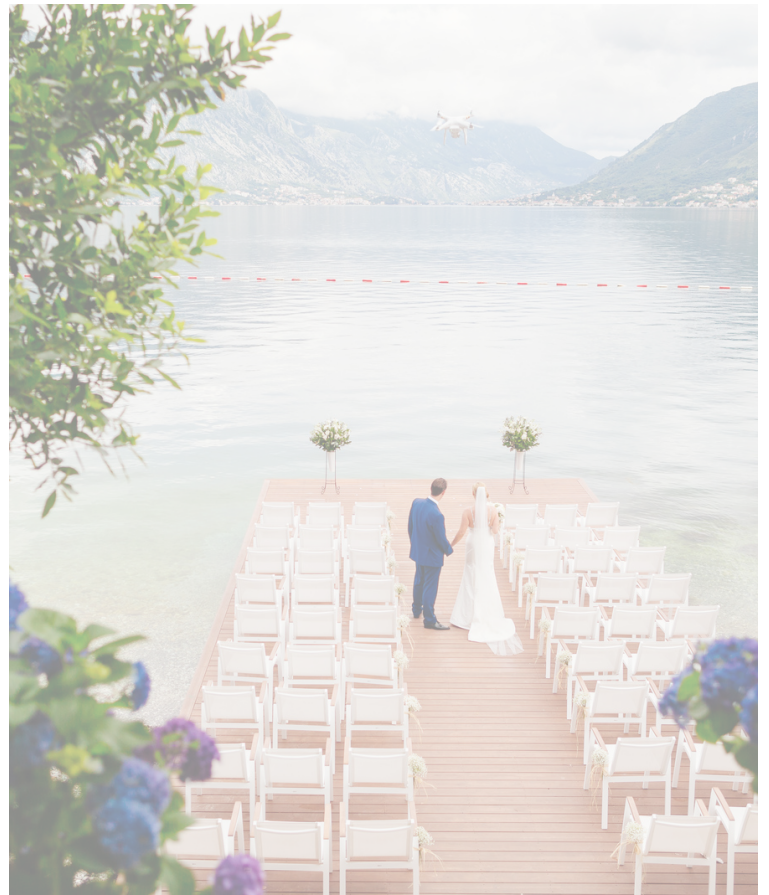
Answering a few questions gives us a clearer picture of the needs of each couple. As we design each wedding with the couple's specific dreams in mind, these answers give us a better understanding of those dreams.

- Consultation Via Zoom

Scheduling a time that works for all parties to meet and discuss the questionnaire and discuss additional thoughts/concerns about the wedding. This is an opportunity to get to know each other to see if working together is right for both parties.

- Contract

If all parties are ready to move forward, the next step would be to sign a contract that lays out the responsibilities of RTC and the wedding couple. That contract will state the terms of the service package being purchased as well.

- Destination/Resort Suggestions

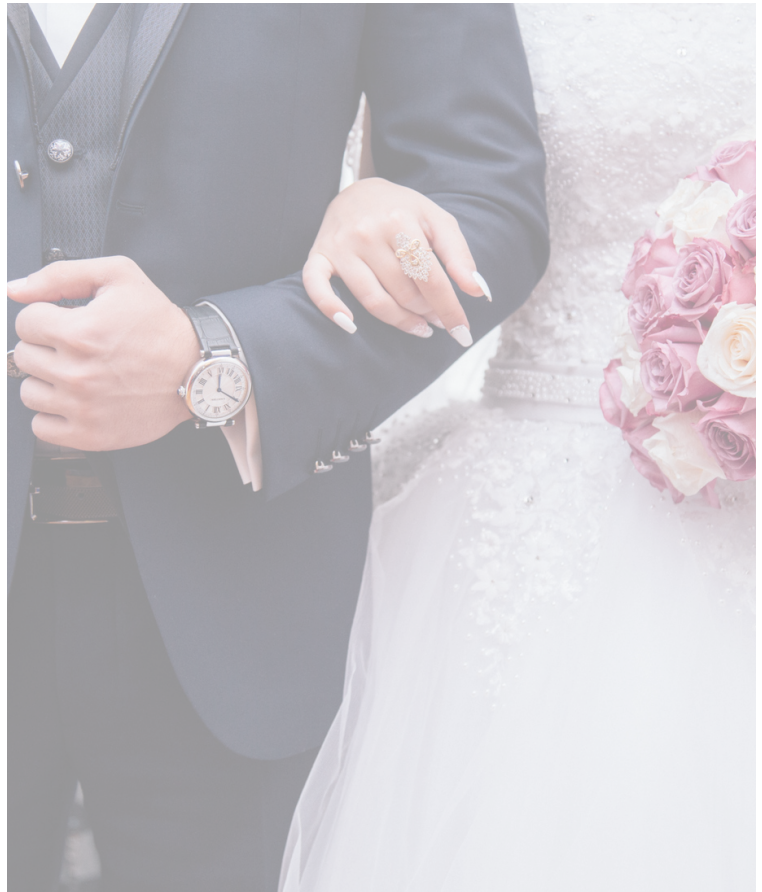
Within seven days of signing the contract, RTC will provide suggested destinations and resorts based on the couple's preferences. There will be three selections provided once a particular destination is selected.

- Contract with Resort

After the location is selected, we will establish a contract with the resort for the necessary rooms for your wedding guests. If a wedding date hasn't been secured, this is often the time we will confirm room availability that coincides with an available wedding date.

- Travel Arrangements

With a wedding date on the calendar and rooms secured, it is time to start confirming guest arrangements. RTC will set up a wedding website for guests to consult information, as well as use a private FB group to distribute information to all guests.

Frequently Asked Questions:

SHOULD I DO A SITE VISIT?

RTC encourages and supports site visits for couples as it gives you peace of mind to know you've picked the right place for you. However, we also understand that your life is busy, and it isn't always a possibility.

SHOULD WE PAY FOR OUR GUESTS TO ATTEND?

It is very common to want everyone to attend your wedding. The real question is, would you pay for your guests to attend your wedding if it was an hour or two away from home? Most would answer no - the majority of destination wedding guests pay their own way. If you can afford to and want to pay for your guests we support that decision.

SHOULD THIS BE AN ADULTS ONLY EVENT, OR SHOULD WE ALLOW CHILDREN?

What do you want for your wedding day? I would consider what you're looking for in a ceremony and make your decision based on your desires. You will have input from other sources, but do not forget this is your day and if making others happy makes you happy, then gather input. Babysitting services can be available for the ceremony if that is helpful as well.

CAN WE PLAN A WELCOME RECEPTION FOR OUR GUESTS?

This is an excellent idea and one that can be fairly easily arranged with the resort. Some wedding packages have this included in the price, while others require an extra charge for this event.

WHAT IF GUESTS DO NOT WANT TO STAY AT THE RESORT THAT WE SELECTED?

Guests attending the ceremony who are not guests of the resort will typically need to buy a day pass to the resort for the days they want to be included in wedding activities+ pay a fee to attend the ceremony. Most often these fees are similar to a night's accommodation.
