
Seasonal Conference Services Staff & Banquet's Team

BILLING & PAYMENTS

Transparency is important to us throughout every stage of your wedding planning process. Below you'll find billing and payment information for weddings at Mission Point. Should you have any questions, please let your Wedding Sales Manager and Conference Services Manager know as they would be happy to discuss.







PRE-PAYMENT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL WEDDINGS AT MISSION POINT.

Payment of your projected master account is required 14 days prior to your arrival. Working with your Conference Services Manager, the couple will provide final food & beverage guarantees 21 days in advance of arrival. Within 1 business day of final guarantees, Mission Point's accounting department will provide the couple an invoice based on the master account. The preferred and most efficient method of payment is wire transfer; however, credit cards and checks are accepted. Credit card payments may be submitted via the event payment link provided by your Conference Services Manager or via phone to the accounting department directly. Checks may be mailed directly to the resort. Regardless of type, payment must be received 30 days post-event.

Should payment not be received 14 days prior to arrival, Mission Point does retain the option to terminate the contract and the couple will remain liable for amounts outlined in projected the Master Bill.

We understand that in some cases during post-event reconciliation, there may be additions or credits to the final account for the event. Final post-event reconciliations and a final invoice will be provided to you within 5 business days of departure. Any credits will be provided back to the couple within 5 business days and any outstanding invoices will be due to Mission Point in 30 business days.

Should the account not be satisfied within 30 days, it will accrue interest at 1.5% per month (18% per annum). If needed to secure payment, the couple has agreed to pay Mission Point all expenses incurred in attempting to collect the balance owed including, but not limited to, all legal expenses and attorney's fees.



ADDITIONAL POLICIES

EVENT SETUP & TEARDOWN

- Check with your Conference Services Manager on the time at which the reception venue is available to decorate.
 Please note that it is possible that the venue will be used by other groups or events on the same day as your wedding.
- Please have your vendors contact your Conference Services Manager at least 2 weeks prior to your wedding date if there are any questions regarding setup or teardown.
- Any décor that you wish to keep must be torn down, packed up, and loaded onto carts at the bell stand no later than 8:00 am
 the following morning. Please note that this time is subject to change.
- Any décor that you wish to dispose of (flowers, trash, etc.) can be left in the reception venue and our staff will take care of it.

DÉCOR POLICIES

- Pillar and taper candles must have a vessel that is higher than the flame and be placed on a candle plate.
- Décor items and decals are not to be fixed or adhered to walls or bars.
- Requests to use pyrotechnic displays, smoke, or hazing must be submitted to your Conference Services Manager.
- Confetti is not permitted.
- Drones are permitted but must be approved by Mission Point Resort and cannot fly outside of Mission Point property.

NOISE POLICY

Hospitality Suites

Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm - 6:00 am nightly. Management may request for noise to be kept to a minimum prior to this time if disrupting other guests. If not compliant, a fee will be charged at management's discretion.

Promenade Deck Pavilion & Courtside Patio

Due to the outdoor location of the Promenade Deck Pavilion and the Courtside Patio, any entertainment planned for the event must be approved by Mission Point (no amplified music) and must cease by 10:00 pm to comply with the City of Mackinac Island Noise Ordinance.







SHIPPING & LOGISTICAL DETAILS

Mission Point is the host venue for a number of weddings each season. You will find that it is just as simple, if not more so, than planning with a hotel property on the mainland.

Please find this information helpful in planning your event.

SHIPPING OF ITEMS

- ADDRESS: Mission Point Resort, 6633 Main Street, PO Box 430, Mackinac Island, Michigan 49757
- Preferred carrier is UPS.
- Please specify on the box the last names of the wedding couple and the Conference Services Manager name for ease of locating packages.
- Indicate each box as 1 of 5, 2 of 5, etc. so all boxes can be accounted for and stored together.
- Please ship items not more than one week prior.
- A \$100/week fee will be applied to items that arrive earlier. This fee must be paid prior to the delivery/pick-up of stored items.
- We do accept shipments from outside freight companies. To complete this process, we recommend reaching out to Arnold Freight.
 They can be reached at 906.643.8288 or email veronica@arnoldfreight.com. Please note that all freight charges are the responsibility of the couple.
- The staff at Mission Point Resort will deliver items to the wedding venue on the day of set up.
- All items must have pre-paid return shipping labels attached at the conclusion of the event.

TRANSPORTATION OF ITEMS

- When you arrive to the island, Mission Point dock porters will be waiting to assist you. Please inform them of the items that need
 to be delivered to the resort.
- If you transport items via passenger ferry, make sure you receive a Mission Point claim ticket for your items from the ferry staff.
- A dray may be required for large items (boxes larger than 4'x 6'). The cost of the dray will be determined by www.mict.com and will need to be paid for by the couple.
- Due to the demands of the Bell Stand, please note delivery of large items may be delayed.
- Any items being taken back on the ferry, must be taken to the Bell Stand for proper tagging and transfer. Please allow up to (2) hours for items to arrive to the mainland.
- Note: Special instructions will be provided for live entertainment

ission Point Resort is home to designed culinary adventures across our 18 acre property with a robust banquet program and unique dining options for all aspects of your wedding. Dining at Mission Point is a farm-to-ferry experience as our culinary team sources a variety of ingredients from local farms and purveyors.

We are often asked, "How does Mission Point get fresh produce?" Our location on an island in the Straits of Mackinac does present some unique logistical challenges in securing regular deliveries of goods and resources to the resort, which must be delivered either by ferry or flight before

a horse-drawn dray delivery. But with a lot of planning and communication between mainland farms, transportation providers and our culinary team, fresh produce, dairy, and other products make their way from farm to ferry and onto guests' plates within a matter of days from being picked.

We invite you to review our Wedding Menu and select the food & beverage options that will best suit your needs. You and your family have a variety of choices from buffet options and plated pairings to late night snacks and morning brunches. Please let your Conference Services Manager know if you have any questions regarding menu options.

We do require a guarantee of the number of persons attending all food and beverage functions at least 21 days prior to your function. If no guarantee is received, MPR will use the number of guests contracted as your guarantee and charges will either reflect the actual number served or the guarantee, whichever is greater. Please contact your Conference Services Manager with any questions on counts, guarantees and menu selections.











WEDDING TASTINGS



our menu tasting will serve as a planning session between you and your Conference Services Manager and is the best opportunity to ask detailed questions of our culinary team. While you are sampling the menu, you will also be going through and making decisions on key aspects of your upcoming wedding!

Complimentary menu tastings are available for wedding receptions expecting 100 guests or more. For wedding receptions with under 100 expected guests, a fee of \$25/person plus a 22% service charge and the current Michigan State sales tax will be charged. Your Conference Services Manager and a lead server from our excellent banquet staff will administer the private tasting.



The following guidelines will help you in preparation for the tasting:

- We do require at least 3 weeks' notice to prepare for your tasting.
- Tastings take place in May and October, Sunday-Thursday, pending availability. Tastings are unavailable on Fridays, Saturdays and over Memorial Day weekend.
- Your tasting is limited to four (4) attendees plus your Conference Services Manager. Additional attendees beyond the four specified will be charged \$25/per person plus 22% service charge and the current Michigan State sales tax.

TAXI SHUTTLE SERVICE

Mission Point Resort is located approximately 15 minutes from the ferry docks and guests may walk, bike or take the horse-drawn taxi shuttle to the resort. Run by Mackinac Island Carriage Tours, the shuttle is similar to a taxi service and will take you directly from the ferry dock to Mission Point for a small charge. Please contact your Conference Services Manager for the shuttle schedule.

LUGGAGE PROCESS

When you arrive to the Shepler's Dock on the mainland, your luggage will be tagged for Mission Point Resort and you will receive one luggage claim ticket for each piece of luggage you have. Once you reach the island, a Mission Point dockporter will send it to the resort and at check-in, you will give your luggage claim tickets to the bellstand for transportation right to your room.

Upon departure, you will need to call the bellstand for pickup and they will pick it up from your room. Again, you will receive one luggage claim ticket for each piece of luggage you have. We ask that you call at least 2 hours before your desired ferry departure time.

An important note: once you send your luggage, it can be inaccessible for a bit. Please keep anything you may need, such as medication, in your hand luggage, backpack or pockets.

At dusk, the putting course transforms when the sun goes down with neon lights illuminating the flagpoles and golf balls and glow sticks for all golfers. Private course rental is available: \$1,000 for Standard Putt Putt (before 9:00 pm) and \$1,500 for Glow Golf (after 9:00 pm). Putt Putt Golf is open seasonally from mid-May to mid-October and Glow Golf is available from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Experience the beauty of Mackinac Island's sunrise side with a guided hike to Robinson's Folly. Start your day off on the right foot by joining a member of our team 15 minutes before sunrise to walk through the woods to one of the best sunrise viewing locations. Private hikes are available for \$50 per group.

Led by our resident horticulturist, our complimentary Garden Tours are leisurely walking tours with an opportunity to explore the gardens of Mission Point, learn about our unique climate and the resort's green gardening practices. Public tours are held from Memorial Day to Labor Day, Wednesdays at 5:30pm and Saturdays at noon. Private group tours are available for \$150 per group.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Mackinaw Shuttle provides shuttle service to Mackinaw City from Pellston Airport. Transfer is approximately 25 minutes / 15 miles. Their fleet can transfer 40-50 people at one time. NOTE: Uber and Lyft services are not available in our area.

FERRY SERVICE

Shepler's is the preferred ferry partner at Mission Point Resort and offers daily boats to and from Mackinac Island. Star Line is also available with daily service as well. The boat ride across the Straits of Mackinac is approximately 16 minutes filled with photo opportunities of the Mackinac Bridge, Round Island Lighthouse and Mackinac Island.

ON-ISLAND TRANSPORTATION

Once on the island, you may take a taxi, ride on the Mackinac Island Carriage Tours shuttle servicing Mission Point, or enjoy the short 15-minute walk.

The Mission Point shuttle is a service offered by Mackinac Island Carriage tours and is a fixed-route shuttle taxi that goes between the ferry docks downtown and Mission Point. This is the easiest way to get to MPR and there is a small charge for riding the shuttle. Please note that the shuttle is not available from 12:30 pm—2:00 pm so the team can change horses.

Horse-drawn taxi service is provided by Mackinac Island Carriage Tours 24 hours per day during the peak summer season. Something unique about Mackinac Island is that taxis cannot be "hailed" and you must call the taxi dispatch office to schedule your pickup. IMPORTANT ISLAND SERVICES

While Mackinac Island is a popular tourist destination, it also has a vibrant seasonal and year-round community with the same services that you would expect in any city.

MACKINAC ISLAND MEDICAL CENTER, POLICE & FIRE DEPARTMENT

Since health issues never take a vacation, the Mackinac Island Medical Center offers 24-hour emergency care for both island residents and visitors. They offer a full range of medical services include emergency room, primary care, x-ray and laboratory.

While cars are banned on Mackinac Island, we do have ambulances, fire trucks and police vehicles. First responders are available 24/7 for any type of emergency and are highly trained. The Fire Station and Police Station are both located on Market Street.

BANKS

There are two banks located on Mackinac Island:

First National Bank of St. Ignace is located on Market Street and **Central Savings Bank** is located on Hoban Street. Both banks have ATMs. There is also an ATM located in the Mission Point Main Lobby.

POST OFFICE

Our post office offers the same services as larger ones although there is no mail delivery on the island—everyone must stop in and pick up the mail from their P.O. Box. The post office is located on Market Street.

OUR RESORT HISTORY

he Mission district of Mackinac Island has deep roots in hospitality and the concept of bringing people together to learn and grow.

In the early 1820's, Reverend William Ferry, a Protestant missionary, used this area to house and teach Native American children. He also established Mission Church, which was one of the first protestant churches in the Midwest. The southeast end of Mackinac Island thus became known as Mission Point.

During the 1940's, an organization called the Moral Re-Armament (MRA) was looking for a world headquarters and became involved on the island upon the invitation of the Governor of Michigan at the time. The MRA was a multi-national group who promoted the philosophy of love, unselfishness, purity and honesty in a worldwide evangelistic campaign. They settled on Mackinac Island and groundbreaking ceremonies began in 1954.

Construction on what are now called the Main Lodge and Straits Lodge began in the fall of 1955 with fifty-foot trusses of Norway White Pine from nearby Bois Blanc Island supporting the roof and 45 tons of native stone forming the original building. The Main Lobby's rotunda-style architecture remains one of the most distinctive structures on the island to this day—nine majestic trusses converge at the height of 51 feet and resemble a 16-sided teepee. This structure fulfils the prophecy that says:

Someday on the east side of the island a great teepee will be erected. All nations will come there and learn about peace.

A movie production Sound Stage was constructed in 1958 and at the time was the second largest of its type in the world; the MRA used this space to produce movies and short films. In 1966, the MRA relocated their operation to Switzerland and deeded much of the property to an organization known as Mackinac College. This education institute operated for four years, graduated one class and then closed in 1970.

Throughout the 1970's and 80's, the Mission Point property changed hands a few times and during this era, was established as a hotel resort. One of the most notable events at Mission Point occurred in 1979, when Universal Studios leased the Sound Stage mentioned earlier to produce the movie "Somewhere in Time" starring Christopher Reeve and Jayne Seymour. Most of the sets were built and utilized in the Sound Stage and the production team used the Theater for filming. The entire cast and crew were hosted at Mission Point, which was at that time was called the Inn on Mackinac.

In 1987, Detroit businessman John Shufelt purchased the property and gave it the official name of Mission Point Resort, paying homage to our historical location. Through the Shufelts' ownership, Mission Point gained the reputation as the "friendly and casual" hotel and resort option on Mackinac Island.

The current chapter of Mission Point Resort's history book began in 2014, when Dennert and Suzanne Ware purchased the property; they had an immediate plan of multi-million-dollar upgrades while also preserving the important historical nature of the hotel. Since their ownership, Mission Point has added Lakeside Spa & Salon, renovated all 241 guest rooms & suites, refurbished the Conference Center, built the Promenade Deck outdoor pavilion event space and done many more behind-the-scenes improvements to infrastructure, fire safety and overall guest experience. The goal of Mission Point is to provide extraordinary Mackinac Island experiences and with the investments that the Ware family has made, the hotel has seen continued success.
