Founded in Baltimore in 1985, Living Classrooms Foundation is a Baltimore-Washington, DC nonprofit that disrupts the cycle of poverty and helps our community become safer, stronger and healthier by meeting individuals where they are and building skills for life. Living Classrooms inspires children, youth and adults to achieve their potential through hands-on education, workforce development, health and wellness, and violence prevention programming. Proceeds from the rental of the Frederick Douglass - Isaac Myers Maritime Park support the ongoing delivery of Living Classrooms' life-changing programs that are making our community safer, stronger, and healthier.

The Frederick Douglass-Isaac Myers Maritime Park is Living Classrooms' headquarters and national heritage site, celebrating the contributions of African-Americans in the development of Baltimore's maritime industry, including the Chesapeake Marine Railway and Dry Dock Company, the nation's first African-American owned and operated shipyard established in 1868. The site honors the legacy of shipbuilding and Baltimore's working waterfront as it relates to African American Maritime and Cultural History, Isaac Myers and his partners, and Frederick Douglass while preserving on of the city's oldest industrial waterfront buildings, the Sugar/Coffee House.

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Maritime Park boasts multiple events spaces, including indoor and outdoor options, to help turn your wedding dreams into a stunning reality.


The venue can accommodate groups of varying sizes, with room for up to 1,000 for outdoor events and up to 180 for seated, indoor

events.

Enjoy the panoramic, harbor views and the historic nature of the indoor space with exposed Baltimore brick and industrial wood beams.



With each wedding reservation, you receive access to all of the indoor and outdoor event options, giving you flexibility, and giving your guests the opportunity to experience both the harbor-front views and indoor historic architecture.



Host your ceremony on the Cardin Pier, where you and your guests can marvel at the panoramic harbor views. The harbor and the city's iconic Domino Sugar sign help create a memorable backdrop, allowing for plenty of can't-miss photo opportunities.

Following your ceremony, weather permitting, guests will mingle in the adjoining promenade and courtyard.



For weddings with a larger guest count (180+ guests), you may be interested in renting a tent for the courtyard for your reception. The courtyard can seat up to 600 guests, allowing your friends and family to take in breathtaking views of the harbor for the duration of your celebration.




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*Note - Tents are not required for weddings of less than 200 quests. Tents are also not included in rental of the venue, and must be rented from an outside provider.





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


For an alternate ceremony plan, you may choose to host your nuptials inside, in the Bearman Gallery. The Bearman Gallery features floor-to-ceiling windows with third-story views of the harbor, and industrial wood beam ceilings. The walls of the Bearman Gallery showcase a local, Baltimore artist exhibit that 💻 rotates four times per year.

As an alternate cocktail hour, you may decide to host postceremony in the Shipyard Gallery, which is adjacent to the museum honoring African American maritime history and the legacy of Isaac Myers and Baltimore's own, Frederick Douglass.



If you decide on an indoor reception, following your ceremony and cocktail hour, your guests will be invited to the Founders Room. The Founders Room is located in the historic side of the building, and features floor-to-ceiling, exposed brick, some of which dates back to 1868.

There are two ships that live on Cardin Pier- the Lady Maryland and the Sigsbee. There is no guarantee either ship will be on the dock for the day of your wedding as we do not control their schedule. We will let you know two weeks from your wedding date if the ships will be present or not.

Parking

Parking is not provided. Clients and guests must use paid lots or street parking at the client or guest expense.

Event Cut-Off Times Wedding must conclude (music off) no later than by 11:00PM.

Deposit & Final Payment

50% of the rental fee is due at signing. The remaining 50% is due 14 days prior to event date.

Setup & Breakdown

You receive 4 hours for setup, and 2 hours for breakdown. Tables, Chairs & Linens

Rental equipment (tables, chairs, and linens) is not provided by the venue and must be rented by a licensed rental provider. You are welcome to use whichever licensed rental provider you choose, but we recommend selecting one of the providers found on page 8. Food & Beverage

All food & beverage must be provided, prepared and served by a caterer from our exclusive catering list (page 7).
