

Venue Pricing

Per night pricing for a: Weeknight \$2,800 Weekend \$4,000 Holiday \$4,800

Accommodation Pricing

For weddings, we require full property rentals, including our nine cabins. Cabins can be booked and paid for by the couple, or reserved and paid for by guests.

Per night pricing for the nine cabins is:

Weeknight \$4,200

Weekend \$6,000

Holiday \$7,200

Five camping spots are also included in pricing and can include any combination of tent or RV campers

Bar Service

As Electric Mountain Lodge is a licensed bar, no outside liquor is allowed at your event. We happily provide beverage service.

Types of Bar Service

Open Bar:

The tab is kept open for the duration of the event and settled at the end of the night, or charged to the card on file

Timed Open Bar:

The tab is kept open for a set amount of time, for example during cocktail hour, after which time it switches to cash bar, and the tab is settled at the end of the night or charged to the card on file.

Limited Open Bar

The tab is kept open for a set limit and once that amount is hit it switches to a cash bar, and the tab is settled at the end of the night or charged to the card on file.

Cash Bar

Guests can pay for their drinks at the time of purchase or can hold their own tab to be settled at the end of the night. Any open balances will be charged to the card on file.

*There is a 20% gratuity added to all bar tabs.

Frequently Asked Questions

Food and Beverage

Q: Do you provide catering services?

A. We do not. While limited add—ons are available, we do not provide full catering, but have a list of recommended caterers.

Q: Can we bring our own alcohol?

A. No. Our Lodge, Bunkhouse and patio spaces are all covered under our liquor license and as such, we cannot allow any outside alcohol. If you have a special beverage request. please let us know and we can procure it for you.

Lodging

Q: Do we have to pay for the cabin rentals?

A: No. While you are welcome to cover the cost of any or all of the cabins for your guests, we can also hold our cabins for guests to call in and book separately, much like a standard hotel. However, any cabins not rented are required to be booked by our couples.

Q: Can we add on cabin rentals before or after our event?

A: Yes! There is no minimum cabin rentals for the days surrounding your event, though the event fee applies if you are expecting exclusive use of the property.

EML Services

- Q. Can we hold a winter wedding?
- A. Yes! Winter is gorgeous on the Grand Mesa, however, in the snow the roads do require snowmobiles or other tracked vehicles.

 Alternately, a helicopter can be rented to shuttle guests.
- Q. What is the smallest wedding you can accommodate?

 A. You are welcome to have as few guests as you prefer, but during our summer high season (Memorial Day to Labor Day) we do require full buyouts of our cabins. During our public season, you are welcome to host a smaller wedding without buying out the property, but would not have exclusive use of the property.
 - Q. Can my dog be part of the ceremony?
- A. Yes! Our property is pet friendly, so your four-legged friends are welcome guests and can join outdoor ceremonies. However they cannot be in any public areas where food is served (the Lodge, the Bunkhouse, the patios).

Vendors

Q. Do I have to use your preferred vendors?

A: No. You may use any vendors of your choosing, however we require your vendors to be licensed and insured. If they are not, we require the couple to purchase special event liability insurance with a minimum \$1 million premium.

Q. When can our vendors set up?

A. Your vendors are welcome to arrive up to 4 hours prior to the event or by 12pm, whichever is earlier. For rentals that may need to be set up earlier, such as a tent rental, there may be a charge for early access.
