# Party Planning Tips

When planning a wedding reception, keep in mind that guests are going to be where the couple are. If you're on the dance floor, the guests will be too!

The DJ needs to be easily visible and near the dance floor so they can see and get a feel for the crowd.  
"Nobody puts baby in the corner!"

If there are older guests, be considerate of their seating arrangements. Try not to sit them close to or right in front of the speaker(s).

If you have a bar or photo booth at the event, an ideal location is in the main room where the DJ is. This will keep your guests near the dance floor at all times.

When choosing songs for your event, take into account not only your taste, but the guests' as well. You want everyone to have a great time at your event!

You don't have to overdo it when choosing your music. Pick 15-20 songs that you LOVE and a few that you're not too crazy about. Let your DJ curate the rest!

You always want to leave the guests wanting more. It's not your responsibility to entertain guests until 2am.

Lastly, when considering a budget for your event, keep in mind the level of your entertainment! It will make or break your event and what your guests will be talking about for years to come!
