

Thank you, for your interest in hosting a wedding at **Mulberry Lane Farm!**

When comparing our rates to other barn venues in our area, you'll note that our structure & pricing is different in the fact you have access to the farm throughout the weekend. This helps in creating a more relaxed, stress-free experience vs. being rushed in and out of the venue in one day.

#### Venue Rental

- Our **2023 rate is \$6300** fee includes access to the farm Friday, Saturday & Sunday (time detailed below) for up to 250 guests. Over 250 guests fee tbd & will be discussed as needed at the time of your viewing of the farm. (5.5% sales tax applies.)

What significant differences that set us apart from “*the other guy?*”

- **Fairytale horse & buggy ride** to your back of farm ceremony.
- **More than just a barn!** It's an authentic farm experience.
- **Entire weekend access to the farm!** The day before your wedding for setup/Wedding Day/Sunday to pick up décor.'
- Altho we have a suggested vendor's list; you are welcome to contract with **vendors of your choice** whether on the list or not.



Rental fee includes:

- **Haymow:** Use of 4000 sq. ft. Haymow for dinner and dance.
- **Dairy Barn & Blacksmith Shop:** Use of these barns as needed.
- **Curtain:** Grand entry into the barn draped curtain.
- **Chairs and tables:** To seat up to 250 guests. (Note: Haymow comfortably seats 200 w/ buffet line, 250 w/o buffet line in the Haymow.)
- **Linens:** For up to 250 guests. (7 linen tablecloth colors & 26 linen napkin colors to choose from.)
- **Farm day prior:** Use of farm day before your wedding from 1PM-5PM for decorating & dress rehearsal.
- **Setup:** We will have tables & chairs in place and ready for you to cover with your selected table linen that we provide & decorate.
- **Farm Animals:** Interaction with our farm animals. (Animal pens are open during our petting farm hours. Guests may interact with animals during that time. Afterward, animal pens are closed, but your guests may continue to roam the farm until dark.)
- **Party Time:** Music & beverages must end by 11:00 PM. Unless tearing-down, off-premises by 11:30 PM.
- **Helpers:** Three MLF “farmers” from 1 hour before ceremony until 8:00 PM. (Farmers assist in parking, directing & helping guests, ceremony coordinating, table tear down for dance, garbage detail, etc.) Liability insurance does not allow us to handle food or beverages.
- **Teardown:** Of standard and usual wedding décor.
- **Restrooms:** Indoor restrooms & lounge area.
- **Day After:** No tear down at the end of your party! Return next day to pick up décor' you've brought in.

Ceremony includes:

- **Farmhouse:** Use of the air-conditioned farmhouse by the bride and her attendant(s) for two (2) hours before the ceremony.
- **Horse and buggy:** Bride's fairytale ride to the back of the farm for ceremony. (Included in the back of farm ceremony only.)
- **Hayride:** Tractor pulled wagons/hayride to transport guests to and from ceremony when held at the back of the farm.
- **Rehearsal:** Upon request, rehearsal walk-through limited to one (1) hour Friday between 1 & 5 PM. Typically 4-5 PM.
- **Seating:** For an outdoor wedding, straw bale benches to seat up to 200 guests. For indoor Dairy Barn wedding, chair setup for seating up to 200 guests.

#### Deposit

- 50% non-refundable deposit is requested at the time of signing the contract. The balance is due 30 days before your wedding day. (Payment plan is available upon request.)

In conclusion, if you find us within your budget, your desired wedding date on our calendar (link below) and would like to arrange a personal viewing of the farm, don't hesitate to contact me via email or phone.

\*Note that Mulberry Lane Farm only host weddings mid-May to mid-Sept. Because of our very, very busy petting farm fall season, we are unable to host Oct weddings.
