LET'S TALK ENGAGEMENT SESSION

Do we have to do the engagement session?

It is not required but I highly recommend it! Not only does it capture this fun season of yours and give you beautiful images to use for multiple purposes, but it gives us the perfect opportunity to get to know each other before the big day.

When should we schedule the engagement session?

We can set up your engagement session as soon as you book! If you are hoping for spring or fall photos, it's best to set it up ASAP as those are busier seasons.

What if one or both of us aren't good at taking pictures?

You won't believe how many times I have heard a bride tell me this! But guess what? All you need to do is be yourselves and let me guide you. We are going to have FUN and I will show you just how gorgeous you are.

What do we wear?

I usually recommend 1-2 outfits. Most couples like to do one that is dressier and one that is casual/more themselves. Coordinate colors, search Pinterest and text me if you need any help choosing outfits!

What location should we choose?

If you don't have a special spot that sticks out to you, I have a long list of location ideas that I am happy to send you. I suggest choosing a location that you both will feel comfortable in.

How soon will we get our images back?

You will get your engagement gallery within two weeks of your session!

How much is an engagement session?

If you choose a package, the engagement session is complimentary! Otherwise they are \$350 an hour.





WHAT WE CATCH ON YOUR BIG DAY

Details

We start the day by photographing your beautiful details. You spent good money and time arranging for the perfect bouquet, shoes, jewelry, invitations, cuff links, etc. I want to photograph those details as part of your story.

Getting Ready

Next comes your getting ready shots. The moments of your mom zipping up your dress, you spraying on your perfume, a cluster of excited bridesmaids ooo'ing and ahh'ing over you. And let's not forget the guys. We capture the men adjusting their ties, putting on boutineers and goofing off as they do!

First Look

A popular option now is doing a "First Look" before the ceremony. This allows you to see each other for the first time alone, exchange private vows if desired, and then do most of your formal portraits before the ceremony, which enables you get the party started faster! This option is totally up to you.

Portraits

Your formal portraits include your gorgeous bride and groom photos, your fun bridal party and family portraits. We like to do a mix of both posed and candid images for the bridal party. And we always have a list of family combinations so we can stay organized!

Ceremony and Reception

Of course, we document your entire wedding ceremony, complete with those big and small moments such as walking down the aisle, the groom's face (it's a favorite of ours to catch!), the dad handing you away, the exchange of rings and the big kiss. Then, we'll capture all the essentials at your reception including the cake cutting, first dances, toasts and all the heartfelt moments in between.

The Send Off

Depending on the package you choose, we may be able to capture your send off. You can either have the send off in between the ceremony and reception (for instance leaving the church to go to a reception venue), or at the very end of the night. We can talk more about this in our meeting too!

Extras

Aside from the usual events above, if there are other moments like a special grandmother picture or a prayer picture before the ceremony, please tell us and we will be sure to capture it!

TIPS AND TRICKS

AND A HANDY CHECKLIST TO KEEP YOU ORGANIZED!

- Create a detailed timeline of your wedding day that includes when flowers are set to arrive, when people should arrive, when hair and makeup will get done, etc. Include exact times and locations. Share this timeline with everyone involved in your wedding, including your photographer.
- Make a Wedding Day Emergency Kit. You'd be surprised at how many times I hear these things are needed! Things you might pack include: safety pins, scissors, tweezers, feminine products, hot glue gun, Tylenol, band-aids, hair pins, spot remover, breath mints, tissues and needle and thread.
- Practice walking in your wedding day shoes to make sure they're comfortable enough to stand around in for your portraits and for the duration of your wedding. Pain is beauty, yes, but looking pained in a picture isn't worth the discomfort.
- While getting ready, have some food, water, a fan, mirrors and music for everyone. Also, if you have matching robes, please let us get a picture of you all in them before you change!
- Gather your deatils. The first thing that one of us will do is come grab your dress and accessories for detail shots! If you could have them all in a bag ready for us to take, that would be helpful! These include: shoes, veil, garter, both rings, necklace, bracelet and earrings. You can put your Maid of Honor in charge of this!

If you are going to be out in the sun before your wedding or tanning, make sure to wear sunscreen and avoid tan lines. Also mention this to your bridesmaids!

- Whether you're doing your makeup yourself or having a makeup artist come in, do a trial run. This is especially important if you have sensitive skin.
- Before your wedding day, have your coordinator or someone explain to you both how to cut the cake. It is always a new experience! The coordinator will make sure a knife, plate and fork are set at the cake table the day of.
- Follow up with all your vendors a week before your wedding to make sure everything is in place and ready to go. Should anything be wrong (say, the florist only has you down for 4 bouquets instead of 5), this will provide plenty of time to fix the mistake.
- Expect the unexpected. Sometimes things don't go as planned, and that's OK. In the long term, it's your outlook and attitude that makes for a brilliant, successful day.

Which venues have you shot at before?

I have shot at almost every Wichita venue, and dozens of churches, cathedrals, barns, backyards, lakes and gardens. You can find a list of venues I've shot at on my blog at cynthiadalenephoto.com/blog. Don't fret though if you don't see yours on the list; I always love a good challenge or a new venue!

Do you travel?

All weddings within 1 hour of 67208 are included. After the one hour mark, travel time is \$50 an hour, covering gas and time.

How many images will I get?

You will receive roughly 75-100 edited images per hour.

When will I get my images back?

Your online gallery with the high-resolution images are delivered within 6-8 weeks! Teasers will also be posted so make sure to follow my socials! @cynthiadaleneweddings

Can I see an example album?

If you would like to see a sample 10 X10 album (that comes with the Gold package), I am happy to bring one to the consultation meeting.

Is there a deposit?

The deposit is 20% of whichever package you choose (due upon booking). Payable either through my Honeybook system or through Venmo @cynthia-vrana

Do we need to have poses prepared?

Posing is my job! We come prepared with a multitude of poses for the bride and groom, bridal party and family. You are welcome to show us styles and sample poses you like as well!

Who is your second shooter?

I work with a variety of talented photographers in the area, and also my husband second shoots for me when he's available!
